Roles/Responsibilities

1. Praise Leader

This person is in charge of facilitating practices, emcee-ing worship sets, acquiring equipment, choosing songs, preparing PowerPoint slides, and ultimately making executive decisions. He/She is the mentor and will keep you accountable to the team as well as to your own spiritual walk.

2. Musician/Vocalist

The musician/vocalist is ultimately the heart of each worship team. He/She is to be independently responsible for his/her instrument of choice. This includes not only the set-up and maintenance of the instrument, but also the independent practice that must take place offstage. He/She is also to help set up and clean up after practices and worship sets and to support the team leader/other team members however he/she can.

3. Audio Technician

The audio technician is responsible for facilitating set-up and clean-up of all equipment. The audio technician will be in charge of all parties, even outside of music ministry, that uses a microphone or other audio-projection equipment. He/She also supports team leader/other team members however he/she can.

4. Visual Technician

The visual technician is responsible for managing and maintaining the power point slides and the overhead projector. That means setting up and operating the overhead projector. He/She also supports team leader/other team members however he/she can.
